Dittman, and Ian Roberts all finished with 34 of 36. We set up a lane specifically for the shoot-off and each shooter was given the customary 4 shots at 2 targets. Ian was relegated to third place in the first round when he missed 1 of his first 4 shots. For the second round, Doug and Justin shot the same lane again, but with the constraint that they could not shoot from the sitting position. Justin chose to shoot prone and Doug shot kneeling, but they both hit 3 of 4 and remained tied. Then they shot off-hand. Again they tied. Finally, we set up the alligator at a range of about 35 yards. Doug won the match by hitting it once out of two shots.

There was not such drama in the spring gun class. Steve Moore won again, as he has been doing consistently for some time now. The surprise was Ron Marcoe who came out of hiding to take second. Ron was followed by new shooter Clark Atkins in third. Where did HE come from?

Apart from that, the food was good, varied, and plentiful and everyone seemed to enjoy the day, which is what it's all about.
